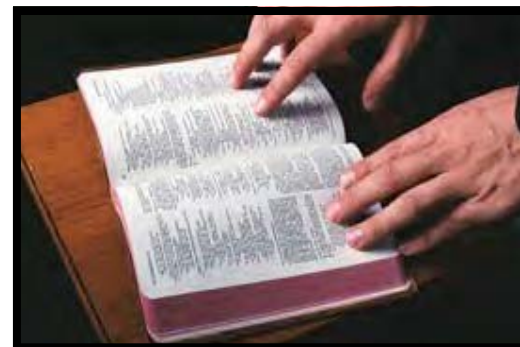

When an expert in the law asked Jesus for the greatest commandment, Jesus responded with the *Shema*, the ancient Jewish creed that commands Israel to love God with heart, soul, mind, and strength.

But the next part of Jesus' answer would change the course of history. Jesus amended the *Shema*, giving his followers a new creed for life: to love God with heart, soul, mind, and strength, but also to love others as themselves.

In this class (drawn from *The Jesus Creed* by Scot McKnight) you will be encouraged to discover how Jesus' greatest commands of love for God and others can transform your life.
