Paul's letter to the Romans is one of the most popular New Testament letters for study.

A study of Romans is as likely to start a revival as it is to make people mad.

Some people have a "love-hate" relationship with the letter, primarily because it is full of personal challenges like dying to sin, responding to God's mercies, and learning to live in community with people who are different from you.

Everyone is offered an opportunity for increased self-awareness as they study Romans. After all, Paul teaches that all people are equally sinners and equally saved.

Many important topics await us this quarter: the universality of sin, the ministry of the Holy Spirit, and the power of prayer being just a few.

This study of Romans provides a great opportunity to grow deeper in your relationship with God.
