“John:

Believing in Jesus”

Written by “the disciple whom Jesus loved,” the Gospel of John paints an intimate portrait of Jesus as one who is intimate with God the Father, who calls disciples to follow him, and who gives signs that point his listeners to God.

In John Jesus tells us precisely who he is:

- Bread of life (6:35)
- Light of the world (10:7)
- Good shepherd (10:11)
- Resurrection & life (11:25)
- Way, truth, & life (14:6)
- True vine (15:1)

Most importantly, Jesus says, “I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you” (John 14:20. This dynamic identification with the Father and with us is through the Holy Spirit. More than any other gospel, John focuses on the Spirit as the vehicle of God’s presence in Jesus and in us. John is foremost a spiritual gospel (from *John: Believing in Jesus* by Gary Holloway).
