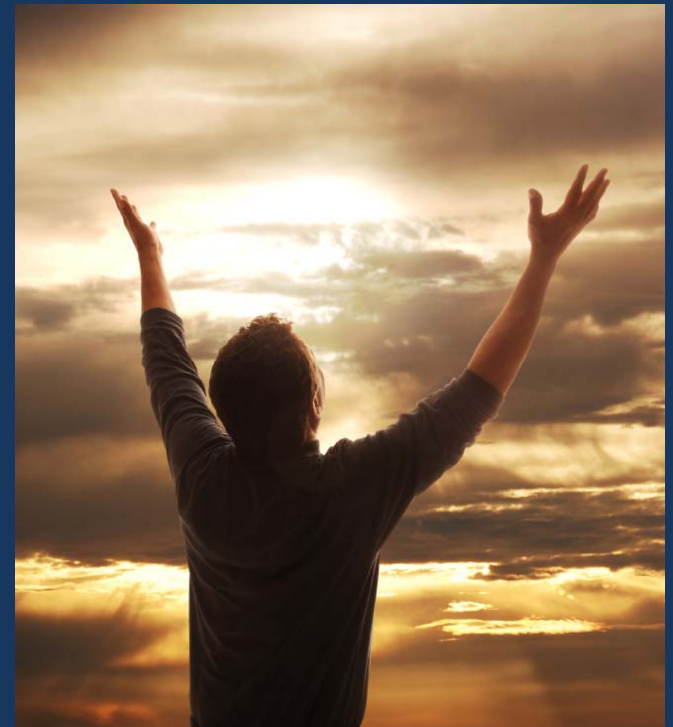


Worship
